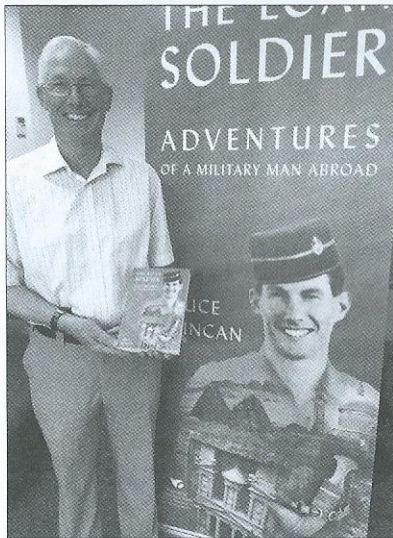


## Some good reading for the winter months
